RULES

- 1) All participants must be registered. On-site registration, Sunday, June 5, 2016 from 8:00 a.m. 8:50 a.m. near Oakwood Street Bridge. Raindate: June 19, 2016.
- 2) The Fishing Derby officially begins at 9:00AM (No fishing before)
- 3) Weigh-in closes promptly at 11:30 a.m.
- 4) Observe and respect other people around you.
- 5) Alcohol or controlled substances are NOT allowed at this event.
- *6) Adults must remain within arms reach of child or child may be disqualified and please let the kids fish by themselves. Volunteers will help as much as possible if parent does not have fishing license. (not required)
- 7) Fish must be caught from shore. Boats, floats and rafts of any kind are not permitted.
- 8) One pole per child.
- 9) All fish caught must be taken to one of Derby Volunteers for official weigh-in. Need to be weighed and measured right after they are caught.
- 10) All fish must be released back into the Shiawassee River after they are weighed and measured.
- 11) The winners will be determined by total length of fish caught. One overall prize for biggest fish determined by length + weight.
- 12) Prizes will be awarded around NOON at the Oakwood Street Bridge
- 13) Winners need to be present to claim their awards.
- 14) All ties will be subject to a random drawing.
- 15) All prizes must be accepted as awarded and have no surrender value.
- 16) All decisions made by event coordinators are final.
- 17) All participants must follow the rules and regulations set forth by the DNR (Department of Natural Resources)
